## **DUKE OF EDINBURGH'S AWARD PRACTICE WALK, 21 APR 18**

#### Introduction.

1. To complete the Expedition section of the Duke of Edinburgh's (DofE) award participants are required to complete 4 mandatory elements; Exped specific training; a one day practice walk; a practice expedition and the final assessed expedition. Training commenced earlier this year and will conclude with a practice walk on Sat 21 Apr 18. The practice expedition will take place over the weekend 19 – 20 May 18 with the assessed expedition 30 Jun – 1 Jul 18.

## Aim.

2. The aim of the practice walk is to consolidate all expedition training to date in a safe, controlled and challenging environment. This memorandum will provide details of the plan and kit requirements for the practice walk.

### Command.

3. Cdr Weaver RN will be the OIC with WO2 Wood RMC as 2IC.

## Location.

4. The practice walk will take place at the Queen Elizabeth Country Park.

#### Timings.

5. The practice walk will take place on Sat 21 Apr 18. Cadets are to muster at HMS EXELLENT at 0830 and will be dismissed at approximately 1600. Detailed timings can be found at Annex A. If the serial is due to finish earlier or later than planned notification will be made on the VCC DofE Facebook page.

#### Transport.

6. The Portsmouth VCC minibus and Land Rover will be required and are to be checked and fuelled for the duration of the expedition by 1830 on Fri 20 Apr 18.

#### Equipment.

- 7. The kit list for the practice walk is at Annex B. Civilian clothing is to be worn, although Cadets may choose to wear MTP/PCS trousers and combat boots if they so wish. A warm, waterproof coat is to be carried in a daysack/rucksack. Cadets requiring a daysack for event should draw one from their Unit stores.
- 8. HQVCC has ordered a DofE t-shirt, cap and beanie hat for each cadet and if they have been received from the supplier they will be issued on Sat 21 Apr 18.

#### Food and Water.

9. Each Cadet will be issued with a 24 hour Ration Pack at the start of day and will be expected to cook themselves a hot lunch at the end of the walk. They will also be required at carry a full water bottle (provided) throughout the walk.

## Mobile Telephones.

10. The Expedition section is designed to develop self-reliance and self-confidence through isolation and remote supervision, overcoming challenges and managing risk as an independent team of peers. Modern mobile phones can seriously undermine these outcomes and compromise the team's attitude and approach to decision making processes during their expedition. To that end Cadets will not be allowed to use mobile telephones for the duration of the of the walk. They can be carried, but must be turned off and retained for emergency use only. Note that the use of a mobile telephones during the assessed expedition will result in a FAIL for all members of the team.

### Parent/Guardian Consent.

10. A Parental Consent form is enclosed and is to be completed and returned to Unit Admin Offices, or emailed to <a href="mailto:vcc.ports.dofe@royalnavymail.mod.uk">vcc.ports.dofe@royalnavymail.mod.uk</a>, by 2030 on Tue 17 Apr 18. Failure to provide a completed consent form will result in a Cadet not being allowed to proceed on the walk, which will prevent them progressing onto the practice expedition in May.
