

# Code of Conduct for Cadets in the Volunteer Cadet Corps



Joining the VCC as a cadet brings with it responsibilities.

The following Code of Conduct is to be followed by all cadets in the VCC:

- Attend VCC training nights and other activities at the specified times on a regular basis, and with the correct uniform and equipment.
- Abide by all VCC and MOD Regulations and establishment Standing Orders when involved in VCC activities or as appropriate.
- Tell an appropriate CFAV if they have any concerns about the way a fellow cadet is being treated either during a VCC activity or at home.
- Not use inappropriate or demeaning language (verbal, in writing, by phoning, via email or via the internet).
- Never allow or encourage other cadets to engage in inappropriate behaviour and contact.
- Not put themselves or others in compromising or potentially dangerous situations.
- Respect others and be tolerant. Show understanding and sensitivity to others.
- Not to leave a VCC activity without permission from the appropriate CFAV.
- Not impose their own religious, political ideals or beliefs on anyone.
- Keep others informed of where they are and what they are doing.
- Tell a CFAV if they are worried about anything or other people.
- Set an example they would wish others to follow.
- Not engage in inappropriate behaviour or contact
- Not use alcohol, illegal drugs or substances.
- Respect each other's rights to privacy.
- Listen to fellow cadets and CFAVs.
- Not bully fellow cadets.
- Work as part of a team.
- Not smoke.
